

ALL NATIVE GRASS AREAS ARE NOW TO BE PLAYED AS PENALTY AREAS:

These areas will be marked with a red line with paint or red stakes :

This includes the following areas :

High grass areas left side hole # 1

High grass areas left and right side hole # 3

High grass areas left side hole # 5

If your ball is in one these areas marked with red paint or red stakes you can still played your ball as it lies without taking a penalty, you are also areas or take practice swings.

There are other options you can take:

You can take relief outside the penalty area for a one penalty stroke.

OPTIONS # 1 You can go back where your last stroke was made (stroke and distance)

OPTIONS # 2 Or take back on the line relief by going back as far as you'd like on the line between the hole and where your ball last crossed the c

OPTIONS # 3 You may take lateral relief within 2 club lengths of where your ball last crossed into the penalty areas .

NOTES : You are not allowed to play a provisional ball when you think your ball will be lost only in those penalty areas HOLES # 1 , 3 , 5

When playing a shot from a penalty area you can remove any detached natural or artificial object (known as loose impediments and movable ob moves when moving a loose impediment you get a one stroke penalty and you must replace your ball to the original spot.
